Dear Ph.D. applicant,

Please follow the steps outlined below:

3. Confirm your shared intention to work together with the faculty member by submitting the "Student Advisor Intention Letter" provided below. Kindly request the professor's signature on the form (electronic signature is acceptable).
4. Please note that you can contact multiple advisors and obtain their intention letters. If multiple faculty members intent to supervise you, please list your priority (**one faculty member can only supervise one "full scholarship" and one "partial scholarship Ph.D. student per application term"**).
5. Once you have received the signed letters, please upload this form and all of "Student Advisor Intention Letter" along with all the required documents to the Taiwan Tech application system. Detailed instructions can be found at
